Dr. A. Charles Ware serves as Executive Director, Grace Relations and Special Asst. to the President at the College of Biblical Studies in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Before coming to CBS Dr. Ware served as president and president emeritus of Crossroads Bible College, a biblically conservative evangelical institution dedicated to training Christian leaders to reach multiethnic urban world for Christ. Dr Ware served as Founder/Senior Pastor of Crossroads Bible Church, Indianapolis, IN (2001-2006), Founder/ Pastor of Bethel Bible Church, Camp Spring, MD (1978-1991 and Founder/ Senior Pastor, Scranton Revival Baptist Church, Scranton, PA. (1971-1978).

Dr. Ware earned his B.R.E. from Baptist Bible College of Pennsylvania (1972) Masters in Div. from Capital Bible Seminary, Clarks Summit, PA. (1992) and an Honorary Doctorate from Baptist Bible Seminary, Clarks Summit, PA. (1993)

Dr. Ware is the founder of Grace Relations Network, he speaks in many venues and serves as a consultant on racial reconciliation and leadership. His ministry is well received by audiences of all ethnic groups.

Dr. Ware has authored, co-authored, and edited several books. Among these is One Race One Blood (Master Books, 2007). Dr. Ware co-authored this book with Answers in Genesis founder and President Ken Ham.

Dr. Ware serves on several boards including: The Association of Baptists for World Evangelism (ABWE), The Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE), Anchorsaway, and the Biblical Counseling Coalition. (advisory board)
